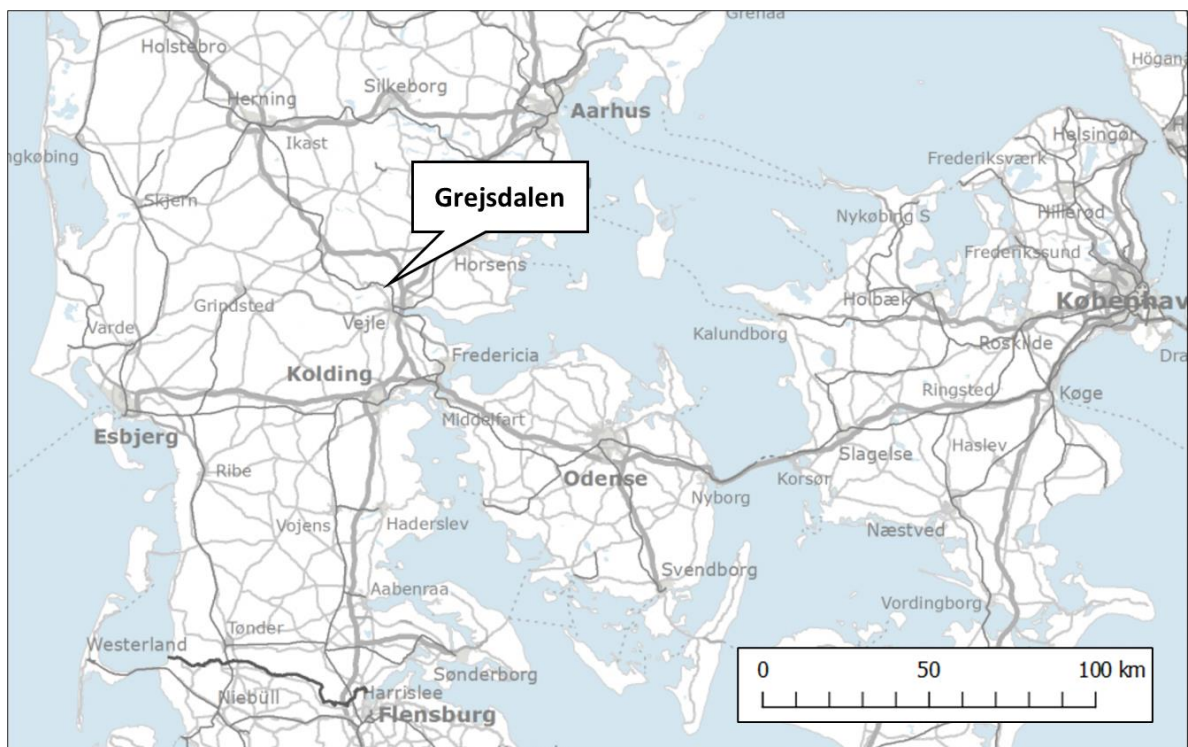


Invitation

Danish Championships Middle, 28 August 2021

You are hereby invited to take part in the Danish Championships in Middle Distance. The race is an open World Ranking Event. Participation in the event can be combined with training activities for WOC 2022. See this [link](#) for WOC 2022 training opportunities. Be careful not to enter the [WOC 2022 embargoed areas](#) when traveling in the area.



Type of competition, format: Middle distance, WRE

Competition area: Grejsdalen

Venue: [Skrædderbakken, 7100 Vejle](#).

Course length: 30-35 min winning time

Terrain: The terrain is located 5-90 m above sea level and is generally very hilly with a lot of contour detail. The vegetation is a mixture of coniferous and deciduous woodland. Runnability is good, but some areas with undergrowth appears. The area is mainly dry underfoot, but there are some ditches, creeks, and marshy areas. The visibility varies from limited to good. There is a well-developed network of paths and forest roads.

First start: 12.00

Prize giving ceremony: Immediately after the race

Embargoed areas: Please find the embargoed area [here](#). The area is strictly embargoed. Competitors, team officials, and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain may influence the results of the competition, are not allowed to enter the embargoed area, unless explicitly permitted to do so by the organisers. The areas are embargoed until the respective competition is finished. It is allowed to pass through the area on paved roads and tracks.

Punching system: Sport Ident. Rental of punching card is possible: 25 DKK.

Maps: 1:10.000, contour interval 5 m, ISOM 2017, drawn in 2021 by Gediminas Trimakas. Examples of pre-existing maps can be viewed [here](#).

WRE classes: W21 (Women), M21 (Men)

Other classes: There will be classes for all ages (W/M10 to W/M90). See information on our [event website](#) (in Danish).

GPS tracking: Yes.

Quarantine: There will be no quarantine.

Travel information: The travel distance by car is about 31 km from Billund Airport, 280 km from Hamburg Airport and 250 km from Copenhagen Airport.

Entry fee: 175 DKK, late entries +100%.

Entry deadline: August 13th at 23:59. Late entries accepted until August 24th.

Payment: Payments shall be transferred in Danish kroner (DKK) to the OK Snab bank account. Copies of invoices can be requested via email to: dmmellem2021@gmail.com. All bank charges shall be covered by the payer.
